- Show office opens at 7:30. Main arena opens at 8:00.
- No dogs allowed on premise.
- Show attire not required. Must use appropriate saddle in each division.
- Horse and rider combination CANNOT ride Walk/Trot classes and cross-enter into classes that canter or lope in the same division.
- Classes 19 & 50 are open to all riders.
- 12 & under divisions cannot cross enter into showmanship at halter 17 & under or any walk trot division 17 & under.
- Walk, whoa, reverse and the 12 & under division riders may have assistance in the arena or on a lead.
- **To qualify for division year-end buckles (except 12 & under, ranch divisions), you must enter a halter class 1, 2, 3, 4, 32, 33, 34 or 35; designate on entry blank which division(s) you are competing for.  
High point will be on one horse/rider basis.**
- Management has the right to combine, split or cancel any class.
- Novice horse or rider may not have won more than three blue ribbons anywhere.
- MHCofT reserves the right to remove any horse, exhibitor, or vendor.
- Vendors or anyone providing services must receive permission from show management prior to the show.
- Auditing classes is allowed. Regular class fees apply, and the number must be worn upside down.
- **Trail and Ranch Riding are the only classes where an exhibitor can have more than one entry.**

## MORGAN HORSE CLUB OF TEXAS OPEN SHOW SERIES POINT SYSTEM

### IN ALL CLASSES

1 <sup>ST</sup> PLACE	6 POINTS
2 <sup>ND</sup> PLACE	5 POINTS
3 <sup>RD</sup> PLACE	4 POINTS
4 <sup>TH</sup> PLACE	3 POINTS
5 <sup>TH</sup> PLACE	2 POINTS
6 <sup>TH</sup> PLACE	1 POINT

### HALTER CHAMPIONSHIPS

GRAND CHAMPION	2 POINTS
RESERVE CHAMPION	1 POINT

### PERFORMANCE CHAMPIONSHIPS (POINTS PLUS 2)

1 <sup>ST</sup> PLACE	6 POINTS + 2 POINTS = 8 POINTS TOTAL
2 <sup>ND</sup> PLACE	5 POINTS + 2 POINTS = 7 POINTS TOTAL
3 <sup>RD</sup> PLACE	4 POINTS + 2 POINTS = 6 POINTS TOTAL
4 <sup>TH</sup> PLACE	3 POINTS + 2 POINTS = 5 POINTS TOTAL
5 <sup>TH</sup> PLACE	2 POINTS + 2 POINTS = 4 POINTS TOTAL
6 <sup>TH</sup> PLACE	1 POINT + 2 POINTS = 3 POINTS TOTAL

### END OF YEAR TIE BREAKERS:

1. THE HORSE AND RIDER COMBINATION THAT CAME TO THE MOST SHOWS THAT SEASON WILL WIN HIGH POINT.
2. IF THERE IS STILL A TIE: THE HORSE AND RIDER COMBINATION THAT HAS MORE HALTER POINTS IN THAT DIVISION WILL WIN HIGH POINT. (EX: WESTERN WALK/TROT AND WESTERN DIVISION WILL USE WESTERN HALTER CLASSES)
3. IF THERE IS STILL A TIE: THE HORSE AND RIDER COMBINATION THAT HAS MORE HALTER POINTS AT THE LAST SHOW OF THE SERIES WILL WIN HIGH POINT.
4. IF THERE IS STILL A TIE: THE MOST HALTER POINTS IN THE HALTER DIVISION FROM PREVIOUS SHOWS UNTIL THE TIE IS BROKEN WILL WIN HIGH POINT.

### END OF YEAR TIE BREAKER FOR THE RANCH DIVISION:

1. THE HORSE AND RIDER COMBINATION THAT ATTENDED THE MOST SHOWS THAT SEASON.
2. THE HIGHEST SCORE IN RANCH RIDING (CLASS 57) AT THE LAST SHOW OF THE SERIES.
