**Exhibitors cannot cross enter divisions with the same horse and rider combination. One Entry Blank per horse and rider combination.**

**To Be Eligible for High Point you must enter the Ranch Halter class in your division 16,17,18 or 19**

**Please designate, by circling, on the Entry Blank what division you are showing for high point.**

Exhibitors are allowed to **AUDIT** any class by paying the entry fee. When entering the class or classes you want to audit, put a capital "A" after the class number on the entry blank.

Example 6A, 21A. When showing in a class you are entered as an AUDIT, turn your number backwards or upside down.

**Pre-Entries are required. Entry Due Date July 17, 2020. If you do not Pre-Enter, exhibitor will be charged a late fee of \$25 day of the show.**

### Other Fees:

Office fee \$20 Stalls \$20 Entry fee \$10 per class \$25 late fee if not entered by July 17, 2020

**Must bring one bag of shavings per horse stall is required by the facility.**

If you want to haul in the night before you must make arrangements with Myers Park,

Mark Page call or text 972-548-4792. You will be charged an additional stall fee for Saturday night.

**Awards** class placing 1-6. High Point Champion and Reserve Champion awarded for each division.

**High Point** will be calculated 1<sup>st</sup>- 6 points, 2<sup>nd</sup>- 5 points, 3<sup>rd</sup>- 4 points, 4<sup>th</sup> - 3 points, 5<sup>th</sup>- 2 points, 6<sup>th</sup>- 1point.

If there is a tie in points the ranch halter class will be the tie breaker. You must enter a Ranch halter class to be eligible for high point in your division.

This is a schooling show so there are no rules on bridles or riding one or two handed with or without noseband. Judge, at their discretion, can penalize or ask you to change any piece of tack or spurs they feel are inappropriate.

**Ranch Rail Pleasure Class-** the horse should be a pleasure to ride. The ranch rail horse shall reflect the attitude and movement of a working horse on a ranch. The horse must have exceptional manners. Must be relaxed, quiet, easy to guide and cadenced in all gaits required. Stop, back and stand quietly. Gaits-walk, extended walk, trot, extended trot, lope, extended lope. Horse will be asked to stop and back on the rail or in line up. Exhibitors could be asked to side pass, 360 degree turn right, 360 degree turn left, turn 90 degrees each way.
